Red Tipped lettuce called "Crawford. It is a Texas Heirloom.


PREPARING FOR WINTER BREAK

Do the following things to prepare your gardens for the winter break:

- 1. Clean up rotting and finished plants
- 2. Remove invasive weeds
- 3. Plant cover crops
- 4. Prune perennials
- 5. Harvest and regenerate your compost
- 6. Replenish mulch
- 7. Clean and sharpen tools

Looking ahead to 2020 we have great things coming. Lets make sure our garden beds are ready for spring planting!
